

Small amount of trees & branches

- Drain any fluids from food waste.
- Trees and branches must be within 5cm in diameter and 1m in length, and dry them before disposal. We cannot collect any larger than the above, so please contact the Cleaning Center.
- Dry grass before putting it in the city-designated bags and take out one bag at a time for garbage disposal.
- If metal is attached and cannot be removed, dispose of it on a non-combustible garbage day.
- Put clothing and leather items in the "Irui/Kawarui kaishu box" for recycling.

No need to make a hole for spray cans, etc.

Spray cans and gas canisters must be disposed of on "Spray Cans Day" without making any holes in them. If there are any contents left inside, we cannot collect them. Please be sure to use up all the contents before disposing of them.



*Please shake cans and make sure you do not hear any noise.

Unsorted Garbage

A rule violation sticker will be attached to the garbage bag. Please sort the garbage and dispose of it again. If you do not know how to sort garbage, please contact the Life Environment Division.

Large amount of garbage

A Large amount of garbage at one time, such as when moving or cleaning house, etc., cannot be collected.

Please contact the Cleaning Center in advance to confirm the date for carrying garbage in, or ask a general waste disposal company licensed by the city to dispose of it.

Garbage from business operations (Industrial Wastes)

Garbage from business operations cannot be collected. (Items used for the same purpose in the past cannot be collected.) Industrial Wastes cannot be disposed of at the Cleaning Center.

Sorting and collecting of Plastic will begin.

Items that cannot be disposed of on "Plastic Day"

- Items that do not remove stains or odors even after washing with water
- Items that cannot be put in the city designated bags (Size: approx. 50cm or more on each side) Examples: blue sheets, raincoats, etc.

(If you cut each side to less than 50cm, you can dispose of them.)

- · Items that are attached to something other than plastic and cannot be removed safely
- PET bottles
- Medical equipment, rechargeable batteries, lighters

How to dispose of dry cell batteries, rechargeable batteries, etc.

- Dry batteries (alkali, manganese)
- Coin batteries (product no: BR, CR)

Put them in the dry battery box at the garbage collection point.

*Please be sure to insulate coin batteries with tape

Small home appliances (including rechargeable batteries), rechargeable batteries

The Cleaning Center and the Life and Environment Division accept them. Please hand them to the staff when you bring them in.

*The Life Environment Division accepts items less than 20cm each in height, width, and depth.

*If any terminal part is exposed to the outside, please be sure to insulate it with tape etc.
